

REV. MARIE BROWN

Rev. Marie Brown is an evangelist/teacher whose consuming passion is to build God's Kingdom. Marie has been preaching the Gospel for over 30 years. For many years her focus was two-fold: (1) preaching the Gospel to multitudes in open air meetings in unreached areas of the world, seeing thousands accepting Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior and many receiving miraculous healings; and (2) teaching believers their identity in Christ motivating them to tap their God-potential through helping others. Her ministry has helped to birth, establish, and expand local churches in over 40 nations.

The ministry's focus expanded in the late 1990's. The Lord placed a message in Marie's heart for the Church to become one—fulfilling Jesus' prayer in John 17. Believing the Church is stronger and more powerful united in purpose, she leads ministry teaching teams into nations to share God's plan and passion for Biblical unity with senior indigenous Church leaders. The call to mobilize, synergize, and utilize resources is paramount. Through these meetings a fresh love for God and people is ignited and a strategy for local and national evangelism emerges. These seminars are called "Networking For Revival."

These "Networking" seminars are specifically being conducted in Rwanda, Tanzania, Cambodia and Myanmar. Marie Brown Ministries has long term commitments in these countries as well as in Malaysia, China and Vietnam.

To assist in the maturing and refreshing of the participating leaders in these seminars, Marie Brown Ministries publishes and contributes materials in the national languages. She has also authored seven books which are widely distributed.

For as many years, Marie has also been involved in helping women discover their identity and dignity in Christ, freeing them for His service.
